The 9th international symposium on "Molecular Thermodynamics and Molecular Simulation (MTMS '21) will be held during September 7-9, 2021 on virtual.

The objective of this three-day symposium is to provide a forum for scientists and engineers to discuss recent advances in the area of molecular thermodynamics and molecular simulation. The symposium is structured with keynote lectures by eminent scientists and engineers, and a select number of oral presentations. Moreover, poster session with chat discussion and flash presentation will be planned.
